News from the Social Ministry Committee

God's Work, Our Hands: This is the message we received from Shelly Davies, Director of Outreach & Education, at St. Luke's Lutheran Church regarding our recent participation in the Blessings Bag project:

Thank you SO much for being part of the **God's Work. Our Hands.** project this year and helping bless the staff of Luther Ridge retirement community in Chambersburg, PA.

We were able to bless 133 staff members with a 'Bag of Blessings' including Lifesaver candy, Lindt truffles, a water bottle, hand sanitizer, tissues, a prayer reminder and \$20 in Butcher Bucks! That's over \$2600 that was raised, plus the physical items that we included! We also received a generous donation from the Lindt Factory Outlet in Carlisle of 1600 truffles and a discount from The Butcher Shoppe for purchasing so many bucks.
