Pastoral Letter – Pastor Bill Nienstedt

[Jesus said] "Then they will see 'the Son of Man coming in a cloud' with power and great glory. Now when these things begin to take place, stand up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near." Luke 21:27-28

We are not very good at waiting, are we? Especially this year, as the pandemic drags on, we impatiently wait for things to "get back to normal." Yet, our lives will never go back to the way they were in the past. The future will bring changes and a "new normal."

We yearn for God to act in our time, not God's time. The good news is that God is patient with us. In the fullness of time, the coming of Jesus is promised. 
