Pastoral Letter – Pastor Barb Barry

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It's hard to believe summer is here already. It seems just yesterday we were preparing for Easter. The newsletter takes a hiatus now. This will be the last published edition until the September newsletter. Most committees take a break as well.

The slower summer pace is a perfect time to reflect on why and how we do things at Solomons. You've met in small groups and filled out a survey to describe how you sense the Holy Spirit calling Solomons into the future. What gifts does your new spiritual leader need in order to help you? Remember, the pastor is a spiritual leader and guide. The pastor can do NOTHING without your mutual help and cooperation. Being open to different ways of doing things and new possibilities in worship and ministry are important pieces to consider.

Summer is NOT a vacation from God. Personal spiritual practice and worship with your family of faith are a vital part of spiritual growth. Relationships take time and that is most certainly true for your most important relationship with God. This seems to be a good time to remind ourselves not only the importance of worship but how worship helps us to encounter Christ.

Our wonderful God, who loves us more than words can describe, who showers us with unconditional love and forgiveness, deserves honor and praise. That's essentially what worship is: honoring and praising God. We do that in our personal devotion time, in our community worship services and even in the way we live. Brother Lawrence, a monk, taught that ordinary tasks like washing dishes or sweeping the floor can be worship if we are intentional about it.

Worship in church is more meaningful if we remember that the service is set up to honor and praise God. It's about God not us. Yes, God meets us there and nourishes our souls through Word and Holy Communion. Yet,

the primary focus is our honor and praise for God. It might be helpful for you to take a minute before worship to breathe deeply, sit in the silence and pray that your heart might be open to what God has to say to you.

The worship services are based on the theme of the Scripture readings. Notice how the prayers, hymns and readings all blend to make a whole. That's intentional! See if you can identify the theme. It's a way to help us chew on God's word and how the Word for the day might be incorporated into our lives. If we're not changed by our worship, we're not paying attention.

Worship is about God not about us. It's important to avoid being a distraction for others who are trying to pray. Stop talking when the service begins. I strongly encourage you to sit quietly and pray during those times when there isn't activity. Personal chit chat during any part of the service is disruptive and makes it hard to pray. After receiving Jesus in Communion is the perfect time to sit in the silence and pray as others receive. The murmur of conversation becomes very disruptive.

I pray your summer is a time of refreshment and connection with God, your friends and family. Blessings on your journey!
