Pastoral Letter – Pastor Barb Barry

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Fall is in the air! Mornings and evenings are crisp to enjoy walks or sit outside with fire pits. I'm not at all into scary but I enjoy the cute Halloween decorations with fun pumpkin faces, cheery scarecrows and little kids dressed up in their favorite characters. For my family, Halloween is the beginning of that long holiday stretch that ends with Epiphany on Jan 6. Fun and hectic times for sure!

Fall is also a time for spiritual reflection beginning with World Communion Sunday. World Communion Sunday is usually celebrated the first Sunday in October. However, Gwen (my new granddaughter), is arriving that week and I will be helping my daughter adjust to her new family. So, we'll celebrate World Communion Sunday on October 9.

The word Communion tells us all we need about why this day is so important. Frankly, why Holy Communion is so important at any time. Communion is a word that is deeper than connection. It points to a shared intimacy. Jesus tells us He is present in the bread and cup in a mysterious way we don't understand. When we receive Communion, we receive Jesus. We take Him into the very cells of our bodies. Communion is one of the ways we KNOW Jesus comes to us. We know because Jesus promised, and Jesus always keeps promises.

In Holy Communion, we also find ourselves connected to – in communion with -one another: those who are receiving Communion around the world, those who have gone before us into the arms of God, those who will come after. It's the very mysterious and wonderful unity of which

Paul speaks in his letter to the Corinthians. We, who are many, are one body, for we all partake of the one loaf. (1 Cor 10:17)

The Worship and Music team are using World Communion Sunday as an opportunity to return to our pre-Covid Communion procedures. Some people expressed the desire to receive Jesus in their hands hearing those blessed words "given FOR YOU!" Others miss singing the Lamb of God and a hymn during Communion.

I strongly encourage you to take Holy Communion seriously. Communion isn't a social time meant for conversation with one another. Instead, take that time to be with Jesus. Pray and meditate on the wondrous promise Jesus is here. Open your heart to receive God's wondrous gift of love and forgiveness and be transformed.


News from the Fund-Raising Committee
