Pastoral Letter - Pastor Barb Barry

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The calendar season of summer is marked by growth and harvest. Gardening is my go-to stress reliever. I love getting my hands dirty in the dirt with planting and weeding. Caring for the plants and watching them grow to maturity fills my heart.

Pentecost marks the beginning of the church season for growing, growing in our trust of the Lord. Pentecost is the day we remember the Holy Spirit coming in gale force winds and tongues of fire resting on the heads of each of the apostles and others gathered in the house. The Holy Spirit that fills our hearts with a spark of the Divine and sets us on fire for Jesus and God's mission for Solomon's.

The growing season of the church is creatively called "The time after Pentecost." It extends for a long time from Pentecost to Advent. It's a "green" time when we place green paraments on the altar and focus on exploring what it means to live as a follower of Jesus. This summer we're going to risk doing something a little different.

Many people have come to me asking questions about worship. They are curious about why we do certain things the way we do. Everything in worship has a purpose and meaning. Many people don't realize the colors, candles, and other things on and around the altar aren't there for decoration. Everything is designed to help us encounter Christ more deeply.

This summer at Solomon's we're going to take some time to explore the Worship Service. We'll take time to talk about the order of worship and delve deeply into the meaning of the Creed and the Lord's Prayer. We'll review together the items used during worship and what they mean. Hopefully, this will give all of us a richer experience of worship.

To make sure we are answering questions you have about worship, there will be baskets at both doors. Write your questions and place them in the baskets. We will make sure to answer them in one of the sermons.

It's hard to hear but worship isn't about you. Worship is an encounter with the risen Christ. Worship is for an audience of one. That one is God. The intent of worship is to adore, honor and glorify God because the One Who Loves us is WORTHY of honor and respect. What we receive from worship is a gracious gift from a loving God. The question isn't "what will I get from worship today" but "what do I bring." It's the difference between fussing about hymn selection or a sermon that falls flat or noticing God noticing you as you pray, sing, listen and receive Communion.

Worship is a vital part of our mission at Solomon's. We proclaim the Good News of God's love loudly and boldly. Knowing what's beneath our worship practices will make that proclamation all the more powerful.
