Pastoral Letter - Pastor Barb Barry

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Close your eyes. Take a deep breath. Rest in God's love. Notice God noticing you wherever you happen to be as you read this letter.

That's how we begin each worship service together, remembering we are there to worship our audience of one. Reminding ourselves that God is our foundation and reason for living. It's God's love which grounds who we are, the decisions we make, the attitudes we hold. Our hearts are transformed and we become more loving in the process. Worship isn't confined to an hour on Sunday morning but colors every hour of every day. Our lives become worship.

It's hard writing this letter; it's the last one. I have come to love this congregation in a deep and abiding way. My prayer is that the Holy Spirit blesses your ministry and guides you in living as Jesus would have you live. May Solomon's reflect God's love and light so brightly that your neighbors wonder what's happening here and want to be a part of it.

I will close with one of my favorite Scripture passages. It has been a guidepost for me in my spiritual journey. May you find joy, peace, and love as you continue to explore who you are and whose you are in your journey with Jesus.

Paul writes in chapter 3 in Philippians:

⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. ⁵Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near. ⁶Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and

supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

⁸ Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. ⁹Keep on doing the things that you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, and the God of peace will be with you.

God's Work, Our Hands Sunday is Rally Day September 10




