Pastoral Letter - Pastor Bill Nienstedt

Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives." John 14:27

On Memorial Day we remembered those who gave their lives in service to our country as we honored the over 600,000 U.S. men and women who have died while on active duty since World War I. World War I was called "the war to end all wars" but sadly we know that this was not the case. Wars, violence, terrorism, ethnic and racial injustices and insurrections seem to be an ever-present reality in our world. In addition, nuclear and other advanced weapons have made the stakes of war even greater.

The powers of the world today have the capability of destroying all life on our planet. Now, more than ever, we yearn for peace in the world. The words of Jesus to his Disciples on the night he was arrested bring us certain hope that through God, lasting peace is possible. The peace that Jesus gives is unlike anything the world can provide. The peace of Christ surpasses all human understanding. His peace comes through the total and sacrificial love of God for all people. For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

Martin Luther King, Jr. once wrote, "Love is the only force capable of transforming an enemy into a friend." In his sermon on the mountain, Jesus said, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God." (Matthew 5:9) Peace and love are integral to Jesus' entire ministry. Peace and love are central to the very identity of Jesus. Peace is possible only when we love one another as we love ourselves.

Unfortunately, we live in a world which is corrupted by sin. Until Jesus returns at the end of time, lasting peace will continue to elude us. Jesus said, "You will hear of wars and rumors of wars; see that you are not alarmed; for this must take place, but the end is not yet." (Matthew 24:6)

As followers of Jesus, we don't just sit around and wait for the final fulfillment of Jesus' promises. We are called to go out into our world and advocate and work for peace and justice. Pastor Dietrich Bonhoeffer, who was executed by the Nazis during World War II, wrote, "The followers of Christ have been called to peace...they must not only have peace but make it." Bonhoeffer lost his life attempting to bring peace during some of the darkest days of human history.

Jesus never said being his follower comes without risk—the world is a dangerous place. But the Good Shepherd promises to accompany us *through* our darkest valleys and bring us true peace.

I encourage you to be an advocate for justice and peace in your small corner of the world. Through your prayers, words and actions, you can make a difference. Each one of us has unique gifts and abilities to enact peace and share the love of Christ with others. And always remember, Jesus has already given his peace to you and he promises to always be with you.

Project Big Love--For the last three years we have participated in Project Big Love. This event provides backpacks, school supplies, shoes, haircuts, etc. to over 1500 area school-age children. We are **NOT** asking you to provide all the items needed for a complete kit, just whatever you feel you are able to provide. There will be a display in the Sunday School room during August so you can see exactly what is needed. The kits will be assembled during Rally Day on September 8. Our goal is a least 25 kits.
