Pastoral Letter - Pastor Michael Allwein

Dear Members of Solomon's faith community,

It doesn't happen very often, but it is happening this year. Valentine's Day and Ash Wednesday fall on the same day. At first glance this seems really incongruent. After all, Valentine's Day is associated with hearts and chocolates. Ash Wednesday is associated with fasting and spiritual scrutiny. I would like to suggest how there may be more of an intermingling of these two than one might expect, on first glance. The two have some deep connections.

Both of these share love stories at their finest! Lent is an invitation to bear our souls, to take our layered defense systems offline, to give God consent to look deeply within us. Lent encourages the action we take to acknowledge and repair harm. While it is important to act to repair the harms that we know we've caused in our relationships and communities, the Christian tradition also recognizes that we are all part of sinful systems.

The feast of St. Valentine honors a third-century bishop who defied the Roman emperor and married young couples in secret. He is associated with courtly love. Because he defied Roman Law by marrying couples, he was imprisoned and later executed, for which he is remembered as the patron saint of love.

Lent is much more associated with desert spirituality, remembering the forty years the Israelites wandered in the desert wilderness as God formed them into the Chosen People, as well as Jesus' forty days in the desert following his baptism. It is a season of walking into the wild, a 40-day journey with wild beasts, with love, beauties, challenges, gifts and visions. It is a journey that begins with ashes and ends with joy! A journey that follows Jesus down into the wilderness, and up to resurrection and new life.

Here at Solomons, on the Wednesdays of Lent, we will once again join the LARC (Lutheran, Anglican, Roman Catholic) faith communities of the Chambersburg area in mid-week meal and worship (see accompanying article in this newsletter). The theme this year is "Drawing Nearer to Jesus." This could be a Valentine's Day theme/challenge.

I hope this Lenten season can be a time when we worship together, both on Sundays and Wednesdays. On the final Wednesday March 20, we will be here at Solomons.

Lent is a season for reclaiming our identities as free people liberated by God, not because we are perfect, but because God called us and we followed. This Lent let's support each other in prayer. Such is the calling of love.

Happy, loving Lent to each of you!


Evangelism is a Greek word, meaning Good News. The word has the same root as angels, messengers who announce good news.
