#### Pastoral Letter – Pastor Michael Allwein

Dear members and friends of Solomons faith community,

The most famous journey in the Jewish Bible is when the Israelites journeyed through the wilderness for 40 years. Their confident strength was knowing how God traveled with them every step along the way. It is hard for me to believe that it has almost been a year since I arrived here as your interim at the beginning of November last year. I have viewed this past year here at Solomons as a journey that you/we have traveled together. I know there continues to be zigs and zags as we steer our way through various challenges, but we never travel alone. We continue to find our way.

At our Congregation meeting on November 17, I will come prepared to share a full report of how I have been working with the Council and Call Committee to explore various and different possibilities of shared ministry as related to other congregations—all exciting and energizing options for how Solomons can continue to be a missional congregation, open to partnerships with other congregations and pastoral leadership models. I want this time together on November 17 to be a time of conversation. Your concerns, questions are most important as we are all viable members and partners in our faith community.

I think of these words by Carrie Newcomer, in her song "Holy as a Day is Spent." As I watch the leaves already beginning to dance to the ground from the large maple tree in our back yard, I think of these words from her song: "I'm letting go of all my fear/Like autumn leaves made of earth and air/For Summer came and the summer went/As holy as a day is spent. How we spend our days, of course, is how we spend our lives. For God's People wandering through the wilderness, the Promise Land was the dream, but the journey was what was most critical and life-giving, even when it became strident and rough.

Thank you for daring to walk this journey together with our faith community of Solomons Lutheran! Also, I'm thinking of a recent prayer, attributed to Pope Francis.

"Lord, teach us to move beyond ourselves, and to set out in search of truth. Teach us to listen, not to entertain prejudices or draw hasty conclusions. Teach us to go where others hesitate to go, to take time needed to understand, to pay attention to the essentials, not to be distracted by the superfluous, to distinguish deceptive appearance from truth. Grant us grace to recognize your dwelling places in our world and the honesty needed to tell others what we have seen. Amen."
