Pastoral Letter – Pastor Michael Allwein

Dear Members and Friends of Solomons Lutheran Church!

"For all the saints who from their labors rest!" [ELW, Hymn #422]

Growing up I had a great aunt who I spent lot's of time with. "Aunt Lucy" was her name. One day, when I was only a small boy, she asked me what I wanted to be when I grew up. To this day, I clearly recall my answer: "*I want to be a man*!" Thinking back to that day, I'm not sure if I was simply trying to be impish or if I had a deeper reason for giving Aunt Lucy that answer, but I remember she was taken aback, not quite knowing how to respond to this little boy's unexpected response. At a time when all small kids wanted to be astronauts, I suspect I was trying to be a bit mischievous.

This story comes back to me at this time of the church year when we celebrate **All Saints**. This has always been a special time for me because it gives me reason to remember so many people in my life who have taught me how to live, how to love, individuals who have been models to me of how to care for the earth, each other, and opening to God—thus providing me a solid foundation for what I wanted to be "when I grew up."

We live at a time unusual for our heroes, those whom we choose to use as models for the lives we wish to emulate. Without role models, how can any of us ever know that what we seek is possible, that what we want is doable, that what we are is enough?

I like it when we talk about the *great cloud of witnesses*, better than the word *saint*. It was Dorothy Day who said, "*don't call me a saint, because I don't want to be dismissed so easily.*" I don't need a figure in a stained-glass window as a model so much as I need real people who are/were worthy and brave, simple and centered, who saw truth and lived it, whatever the cost. I need to experience people who witness their faith!

The important question for me at this time of the year is, what kind of *witnesses—saints*—are we ourselves being to those who come after us—those still searching for heroes, looking for models, those still wondering what they want to be when they grow up!

I rest comfortably in the poetry and writings of Jan Richardson. She holds that part of me that longs for meaning in the contours of my heart.

Here is a prayer of Jan's for this month of **All Saints**:

For those who walked with us, this is a prayer. For those who have gone ahead, this is a blessing. For those who touched and tended us, who lingered with us while they lived, this is a thanksgiving. For those who journey still with us in the shadows of awareness, in the crevices of memory, in the landscape of our dreams, this is a benediction.
