Pastoral Letter - Pastor Michael Allwein

Dear Family and Friends of Solomons Lutheran Faith Community!

I sat to write this newsletter reflection on the day after we experienced a six-inch snowfall accompanied by frigid temperatures. I'm in awe of the silky glossy snow in our backyard! I filled the bird feeder just a day before the snow arrived, so the birds are feasting on food which most often is difficult to find on these snowy winter days. This all speaks of Hope!

The dazzling sunlight echoing off the snow reminds me that we are in Epiphany, the season in the Christian year of widening light. The winter solstice is past. The light rises and spreads! The light reveals and surprises! The light beckons and guides! The full moon is speculator in its nighttime beauty! *God-with-us* was born and escaped Herod's wrath. The Child of Light has come into the world. The Magi are heading home by another road. The route is unfamiliar, and yet, the Light grows as they journey. This is the time of stars, the millions of suns that dot the obsidian skies.

On the Sunday of <u>Epiphany Two</u>, we sang in the Gathering Song, *Christ, whose glory fills the skies, the true and only light. Sun of righteousness, arise, triumph o'er the shades of night;* Dayspring from on high, be near; Daystar in my heart appear.

The conjunction of Epiphany—the season of light—in this year, 2025, which already has presented its challenges—is a profound, disorienting spiritual tension. My own soul is straining between the revelatory brilliance of God's epiphany with many of the events surrounding our

world today. Dazzled by grace, as is the snow in my yard, I'm seeking deeper lightness and hope in the headlines wanting to overpower us.

Epiphany is the Church season that challenges us to see the stars, even when the sky looks dark. Epiphany challenges us to keep looking to the stars, beyond the clouds. Not in denial, but to remember that even when the inky shroud is there, the light still is. That is the hope and beauty and power of Epiphany! This season of the alternative year, the Christian year, our spiritual year, holds treasures and wisdom for this moment.

Daily life now requires prayer and discernment more than knee-jerk responses toward either end of the political and cultural spectrum. Even when the full moon wanes and snow begins to melt, the light—Light—remains. That Epiphany Hymn still stirs me that, "...the Sun of righteousness arises and will triumph o'er the shades of night."

My Epiphany Prayer: "Dayspring from on high, be near!
